Mpact Girls & Royal Rangers FAQ

What is Mpact Girls? is a mentoring program for girls K-8th grade and offers girls the opportunity to realize their full potential in Christ. For more info- check out www.ngm.ag.org

What is Royal Rangers? Royal Rangers is a mentoring program for boys K-8th grade. It uses activities boys love to teach them life and leadership skills, while also developing Christian character. For more info- check out www.royalrangers.com

Where are these programs located? **Douglas Assembly of God. 501 S. 4th Street Douglas, WY.**

What should my children bring each week? Their uniform t-shirt and a positive attitude. Some groups may have a project that requires children to bring something else; group leaders will keep you informed.

What time does everything begin and end? Dinner is served at 5:30pm. Programs start at 6:15pm. **Programs end at 7:45pm.**

Did you say dinner? Yes! we serve a full dinner from 5:30-6:00pm. Parents and families are welcome to join us.

Is transportation provided? We do provide transportation. Parents need to call 307-359-8958 to set up transportation. We do transport children from the Boys and Girls Club. **We do not provide transportation home, parents are responsible to pick up their children.**

What do these programs cost? Just \$10 for the year. A T-shirt is included with registration.

Can the parents attend the program? Yes, parents are welcome. Regularly attending parents will be subject to a background check.

Weather Cancellations, how will we know? In the case of a cancellation due to weather or any other situation, a mass text will be sent to all the parents. Also be sure to check the church website or Facebook page.

What is the policy concerning communicable diseases? Any child with contagious illness will not be allowed to attend. This includes but not limited to lice, vomiting, diarrhea, flu, chicken pox, and any other illness that causes fever. If a child has a fever of 100 degrees or more or a child is feeling sick or not well, parents will be called to pick up their children. Children can return when they are not sick.

Do these programs run all year long? They run September through May. Consult our calendar or website for start and end dates.
